

## Environmental Management Procedure (EMP) 4.4.6.10 Tab 6

### Subject: Management of Furbearers

1. Purpose: This EMP establishes the procedures for the management of furbearers on Fort Eustis.
2. Document Control: This is a controlled document. Controlled documents are updated as required, reviewed at least annually, and re-dated if changed. Any documents to include blank forms appearing in paper form are not controlled and should be checked against the file version prior to use on the:

4. Scope: This EMP applies to all Activities and personnel, including military, civilians, vendors, suppliers, and contractor personnel who enter JBLE-Eustis. The definition of an Activity can be found in JBLE I 32-101.
5. Roles and Responsibilities:
  - A. CED/EE will manage the furbearer population within the installation's carry capacity in accordance with the INRMP.
  - B. CED/EE will manage the furbearer trapping program.
  - C. CED/EE will monitor furbearer/human incidences and disease outbreaks.
  - D. CED/EE will conduct wildlife depredation supplemental to the furbearer trapping program when necessary.
6. Procedures:
  - A. Maintain trapping data and wildlife/human incidences.
  - B. Manage the furbearer trapping program and set harvest guidelines to ensure the sustainability of furbearer populations and minimizing furbearer/human interactions.
  - C. Conduct depredation trapping when necessary to supplement the furbearer trapping program to ensure appropriate numbers of potentially problematic species are harvested each year or in areas where recreational trapping is prohibited or limited.
