## What is a Spill?

<u>ANY</u> spilling, leaking, pumping, pouring, emitting, emptying or dumping of any quantity. This includes liquids, solids and gases!

What types of hazardous materials are included in spill prevention and immediate response?

- All petroleum oil such as MOTOR OIL, USED OIL, LUBRICAT-ING OIL, GREASE, HYDRAULIC FLUID, BRAKE FLUID, ETC...
- All FUELS such as GASOLINE, DIESEL, #2 FUEL, JP8, KERO-SENE, ETC...
- Serviceable products such as obtained from the HazMart including ANTIFREEZE, PAINT, PAINT THINNER, METHANOL, SOLVENTS, SULFERIC ACID and many others.
- Compressed gases such as ACETYLENE.
- Also includes hazardous waste and non-hazardous wastes!
