Master Sergeant John Lugo is the United States Air Force's F-22 Raptor Aerial Demonstration Team Superintendent, based at Joint Base Langley-Eustis, Virginia. As the aerial demonstration team Superintendent, he is responsible for representing Air Combat Command, the United States Air Force, and the Department of Defense at more than 20 air shows annually. He leads the 12-member enlisted F-22 Demonstration Team and oversees all maintenance actions performed on the Raptor. By doing so, he ensures the demonstration pilot is equipped with a safe, reliable, and effective jet to execute maneuvers for more than 10 million spectators around the world each year. MSgt Lugo also serves as the narrator during demonstration performances. MSgt Lugo was born in El Paso, TX, and graduated from Marcos De Niza High School in Tempe, AZ in 2003. On 2 March 2004, he enlisted into the United States Air Force and then the Virginia Air National Guard in 2020.

MSgt Lugo is currently in the Virginia Air National Guard's 192nd Wing located at JB Langley-Eustis. He has held various positions within the VAANG along with the 1st Maintenance Group, and the 18th Maintenance Group located at Kadena AB, Japan. His latest assignment brings him to the reigns of the Superintendent of the F-22 Demonstration Team. He has toured and deployed all over the world supporting numerous joint force contingency operations.
