Chief Master Sergeant Maynard B. Peregoy is the Superintendent for the 633d Mission Support Group, Joint Base Langley-Eustis, Virginia. He serves as the senior enlisted advisor to the Commander on matters influencing the morale, welfare, quality of life, training, discipline, and professional development for 2,200 assigned personnel across six squadrons. He supports civil engineering, security forces, communications services, force support, logistic readiness, and contracting for a 3,600 acre base community supporting 151,000 active, civilian, and retired personnel.

Chief Master Sergeant Peregoy entered the United States Air Force on 17 April 2001. He graduated from the Air Transportation course at Lackland AFB, Texas, in July 2001. As an Air Transportation journeyman, CMSgt Peregoy was assigned to Ramstein Air Base, Germany. After 6 years in the Air Transportation career field, CMSgt Peregoy voluntarily cross-trained into the Communications career field. He graduated from Client Systems training at Keesler AFB, Mississippi, in March 2007 and was assigned to Dover AFB, Delaware. He became a First Sergeant in November 2013 and was assigned to Holloman AFB, New Mexico. He has been assigned to bases in Germany, Delaware, Georgia, New Mexico, Virginia and California.
