Chief Master Sergeant Terrance J. Kaup is the Superintendent for the 633d Mission Support Group, Joint Base Langley-Eustis, Virginia. He serves as the senior enlisted advisor to the Commander on matters influencing the morale, welfare, quality of life, training, discipline, and professional development for 2,100 assigned personnel across six squadrons. He supports civil engineering, security, communications services, force support, logistic readiness, and contracting for a 3,600 acre base community supporting 151,000 active, civilian, and retired personnel.

CMSgt Terrance J. Kaup grew up in Stuart, Nebraska and enlisted in the Air Force on 11 June 2002 as a Structural Apprentice. Throughout his career, he has been stationed in Idaho, Japan, and Virginia and filled a variety of assignments at the base, major command level, and Air Force Recruiting Service, including Prime BEEF Manager, Heavy Repair Superintendent, and Enlisted Accessions Recruiter. He has deployed in support of Operations IRAQI FREEDOM, ENDURING FREEDOM, FREEDOMS SENDINEL, and INHERENT RESOLVE.
