Chief Master Sergeant Lisa M. Williams is the Superintendent, 633d Medical Group, USAF Hospital Langley, Joint Base Langley-Eustis, Virginia. She is the enlisted leader and primary advisor to the commander directing a \$74M budget to organize, train and equip 1,400 staff in 6 squadrons supporting global medical contingencies and wartime deployments for one of the largest inpatient facilities in the Air Force. She leads 31 clinical product lines to deliver Trusted Care for over 109,000 eligible beneficiaries in the Tidewater Virginia enhanced Multi-Service Market.

Chief Williams grew up in Sauk Centre, Minnesota and entered the Air Force in September 1993.
