### COLONEL CRAIG A. KEYES

Colonel Craig A. Keyes is the commander of the 633d Medical Group, USAF Hospital Langley, Joint Base Langley-Eustis, Virginia where he leads an inpatient facility with a staff of 1,400 active-duty and civilian medical personnel. In this role, he is responsible for ensuring maximum wartime clinical readiness and providing high quality, safe, trusted patient care for 417,000 beneficiaries in the Tidewater Virginia enhanced Multi-Service Market.

Prior to joining the Air Force, Col Keyes worked for two civilian health systems and completed a residency in hospital administration at the Geisinger Health System. He is board certified in health care management.

Colonel Keyes has served at six medical groups, one medical wing, and as a staff officer at Air Mobility Command and then the Air Force Medical Support Agency. He deployed to the Craig Joint Theater Hospital, Bagram Airfield, Afghanistan twice, including serving as the hospital Deputy Commander, supporting advanced trauma care and theater aeromedical evacuation operations. Col Keyes previously served as Commander 4th Medical Group, Seymour Johnson AFB, 374th Medical Support Squadron Commander and 374th Medical Group Administrator in Japan for two years.
