

Furniture

Furniture issued by the government and in serviceable condition must be turned into DLA in Norfolk, VA.

Damaged wooden furniture can be placed in the designated scrap wood contains. **DO NOT place in dumpster!**

Oil Antifreeze

Motor oil can be taken to the Recycle Center or the Hazardous Waste Facility. Antifreeze must be taken to an automotive shop in order to be disposed of/recycled.

Batteries

-Lead acid-batteries should not be placed in dumpsters or containers. They can be taken to the Recycle Center or stores that sell like products (i.e. auto parts store; Battery Plus at 3412 W. Mercury in Hampton).

-Alkaline batteries should be thrown in the regular trash.

-Lithium, nickel-cadmium, and mercury batteries are to treated as *universal waste*. Separate them into different containers and place a Universal Waste label on the container (obtained through the 733 CED, Environmental Element). These can also be recycled at Battery Plus.

The Recycle Center has a commercial paper Shredder and a Classified or higher paper shredder for use.

Recycling Program

Overview

In order to promote pollution prevention, JBLE-Eustis utilizes a program that incorporates reduction, recycling, composting, energy recovery (incineration), and land filling. Recycling is a program encouraged base wide with a specific area at each facility meant as a collection area for most recyclables. Other facilities such as the scrap yard and Defense Logistics Agency-Disposition Services (DLA) are available to aid in the recycling of materials that cannot be put into the collection bins.



Commingled Materials

Materials such as newspapers, colored paper, magazines, #1 and #2 plastics, cans and glass jars should be placed into the commingle bins. Bins for these mixed items are also located at the base recycling center.

White Office Paper

In commingle bins. Shredded office paper must be put in a clear plastic bag and placed on top of bins. Contractors collect these every week. **Do not shred CDs in same container as paper.**

Cardboard

Cardboard has its own separate bins or may be brought to the Recycle Center. These bins are beige and are usually found by dumpsters. Breakdown the boxes before placing them in the bin and **do not place cardboard contaminated with food** (i.e. pizza boxes) in the container.

Ink Cartridges

Toner cartridges are to be placed in the box replacement came in or clear plastic bag, tied off, and taken to the Recycle Center. **They should not be placed in commingled bins.**

Plastic Shopping Bags

DO NOT place in commingled bins.

Recycling bins are located inside the Recycle Center, the Commissary or at local grocery stores.

Metal

All types of metal are acceptable for recycling on base at the Recycle Center (M, W, F - 0730-1500). Any liquids must be removed prior to dropping items off. Paint cans lids off and paint dried up.

Wood

Serviceable wooden pallets should be taken to the scrap area at the Recycle Center (M, W, F - 0730-1500). Unusable wood limbs and leaves can also be brought to Recycle Center.

E-Waste

Contact the Recycle Center to see which items can be disposed through them; then, contact DLA to dispose of all other government electronics. **DO NOT place any electronics in dumpsters or recycling bins.** If the screens to these devices are broken, contact your Facility Manager for proper procedures to dispose of them as hazardous waste. Non-government appliances in good working condition may be donated to organizations such as Goodwill or the Salvation Army.

C & D Debris

These are materials resulting from construction and demolition. The contractors are responsible for the management and removal of these materials. Any materials that are not recycled by the Recycle Center are disposed of at the Bethel Sanitary Landfill.
