Senior Airman Jeremy Ysa is a Dedicated Crew Chief on the F-22 Raptor Demonstration Team and a member of the 27th Fighter Squadron. As a Crew Chief, he is responsible for performing detailed inspections, diagnosing malfunctions, replacing components, looking over aircraft maintenance documentation, and ensuring the aircraft is safe for aircrew to fly.

He represents Air Combat Command, the United States Air Force, and the Department of Defense at more than 20 air shows annually. His mission is to ensure the demonstration team has a quality aircraft available to perform a safe demonstration so that millions of spectators are able to see the F-22's air superiority.

Ysa enlisted in the Air Force on March 14, 2017. He is from Brooklyn, New York and graduated from

Hampton High School in 2016. Joining the Air Force and becoming a tactical aircraft maintainer is his first job, coming in straight out of high school was a humbling experience, but it didn't take too much time for him to pick things up and get the ball rolling.
