Master Sergeant George Fagan is the United States Air Force's F-22 Raptor Aerial Demonstration Team Superintendent, based at Joint Base Langley-Eustis, Virginia. As the aerial demonstration team superintendent, he is responsible for representing Air Combat Command, the United States Air Force, and the Department of Defense at more than 20 air shows annually. He leads the 12-member enlisted F-22 Demonstration Team and oversees all maintenance actions performed on the Raptor. By doing so, he ensures the demonstration pilot is equipped with a safe, reliable, and effective jet to execute maneuvers for more than 10 million spectators around the world each year. Fagan also serves as the narrator during demonstration performances. Fagan was born in Manila, Philippines, and graduated from Harlem High School in 2003. On 23 October 2007, he enlisted into the United States Air Force.

Fagan has held various positions within the 1st Operations Group located at JB Langley-Eustis in Hampton, Virginia, and the 325th Maintenance Group located at Tyndall AFB, Florida. His latest assignment brings him to the reigns of the Superintendent of the F-22 Demonstration Team. He deployed in support of Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Inherent Resolve and Operation Spartan Shield.
