Staff Sergeant Matthew Sanchez is a Dedicated Crew Chief on the F-22 Raptor Demonstration Team and a member of Crash Damaged Disabled Aircraft Recovery team. As a Crew Chief, he is responsible for performing detailed inspections, diagnosing malfunctions, replacing components, looking over aircraft maintenance documentation, and ensuring the aircraft is safe for aircrew to fly.

He represents Air Combat Command, the United States Air Force, and the Department of Defense at more than 20 air shows annually. His mission is to ensure the demonstration team has a quality aircraft available to perform a safe demonstration so that millions of spectators are able to see the F-22's air superiority.
