Access Procedures

To gain access to Joint Base Langley-Eustis and have a seamless time getting a pass through the Visitor Control Center (VCC), all guests must follow this protocol.

Visitor Control Center (VCC). The VCC is located in Bldg. 5, adjacent to LaSalle Gate.

Open: Mon – Fri, 0700 – 1630 Passes needed between 1630 - 0700 may be obtained at the Main Gate.

The VCC issues passes from 1 – 30 days. When submitting pass requests in person, the sponsor must provide their full name, rank, organization or residence (as applicable) and phone number. Additionally, for all visitors, provide the full name, destination and the arrival/departure dates/times. When submitting pass requests through email, ensure all visitors are arriving during hours of operation, are submitted individually and all required fields are completed.

Only 9 personnel may be sponsored at one time. When sponsoring 10 or more visitors refer to Pass & Registration. This does not apply to contractors identified to sponsor subcontractors.

Passes will be issued for the specific time, date and location for which unescorted access to the installation is requested.

Passes will be turned into the Visitor Center upon expiration or departure from the installation when no longer needed.

Visitors arriving substantially earlier than requested will not be issued a pass until the predesignated date/time; unless, the sponsor can be contacted.

Access Procedures

DoD Affiliates who may sponsor Common Access Card (CAC) holders (to include Contractor CAC holders).

• Regular component, Guard and Reserve personnel on official orders, Military retirees, Dependents and Foreign National Affiliates with a U.S. DoD CAC.

Non-DoD Affiliates who may sponsor visitors.

- Veteran Health Identification Card holders with special provisions herein and DEERS qualified minor children.
- Persons 18 years of age or older must present one of the approved documents on the adjacent page.

Contractors are subject to all ID requirements, but must enter the installation at the Large Vehicle Inspection Site (LVIS) across from the Armistead Gate if driving a commercial vehicle.

Langley AFB Hospital

Persons requesting access to Langley AFB Hospital must be pre-announced by a patient or relative with an authorized installation access credential. Since a patient may be incoherent or incapacitated, the staff may make the call on behalf of the patient. Passes will be issued at the Visitor Control Center with the following provisions:

- Not to exceed 30 days
- Limited to the Langley AFB Hospital
- No Escort Privileges

Access Procedures

Veterans' Health Identification Card (VHIC) Holders.

VHIC Holders must bring current VHIC and approved **REAL ID** or supplemental ID as listed on this pamphlet to the VCC. VHIC cards will be enrolled for a period of 3 years, after which a reevaluation will be made. VHIC holders are still subject to a favorable background check and may be denied access if disqualifying factors are found. VHIC holders may be accompanied by up to 5 personnel who are in possession of the approved **REAL ID** or supplemental IDs as listed on this pamphlet. Accompanied personnel must be in the presence of the VHIC ID holder. VIC holders will still be required to be issued a 1-day pass on each visit until issued the VHIC.

Identification/Driver's License

Must be current/valid. The Virginia (VA) Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) is now offering federal compliant **REAL ID Act** driver licenses and identification (ID) cards. VA driver licenses and ID cards without any markings in the upper left hand corner are sufficient for identity proofing without supplemental sources until required by the State of Virginia.
